

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Subject: School fees

As we remain confined to our homes in keeping with the lockdown declared by the Government of India to arrest the spread of the COVID 19 pandemic we are doing our best to cater to the academic growth of our dear students through digital content based online classes which are being conducted from 6th of April 2020 and will continue for the time being.

We are sure you would appreciate the fact that the school being a private, unaided institution, is completely dependent on the fees paid by the guardians to meet all its expenses and to pay salary to its staff. There are various fixed expenses associated with any establishment which have to be incurred even when they are closed. We are also committed to implement the revision of pay and allowances for our members of staff, in line with the State Government's recommendations.

However, any school, as a responsible institution tasked with building tomorrow's citizens, cannot survive in isolation in the prevailing global situation and must do its bid to alleviate the uncertainty and resultant misery so many citizens are faced with, which also include guardians of our children. Accordingly, we would like to inform all parents that the fee enhancement planned by the school for the academic year 2020-21 is presently being held in abeyance. The school shall charge presently through NACH an amount equal to the tuition fee for the month of April 2020 as per the fees charged in the session 2019-20, for the time being, such charge being made on or about 30th April 2020. Other parents may pay the school fees online (through NEFT/RTGS/any other means) within the above mentioned due date. We have been charging the fees on a bimonthly basis, yet presently, to mitigate any hardship, the school fee is being charged on a monthly basis till further notice. We hope that by the month of May or June, some clarity will emerge in the matter and we will be in a better position to decide on implementation of the fee structure for the whole year. Guardians whose wards have been newly admitted to the School and who have already made payment based on the revised fee structure will be informed about the further course of action regarding their fees, later once we reopen.

We also understand that for reasons of economic hardships, some guardians may not be able to keep their accounts funded on the fee collection date and hence their NACH collection may fail. We assure such guardians that their case will be handled with full sympathy that it deserves, and we will allow them adequate time, at least till 15 May 2020, to make the payment to the school without any fines. They should however send an email addressed to the Principal to mpbfhsschool@bsnl.in from their registered email id giving reasons for such failure, to be eligible for the concession in fines.

Our teachers are trying their best under the given situation to create digital content and assignments so that our students can be fruitfully engaged and their academic progress remain unhindered till such time they are able to attend normal classes. We appreciate your whole hearted participation in the process as you continue to monitor your ward(s) at home.

Please take care of yourselves and your family members. With the efforts of one and all and by the grace of the Almighty, we will soon overcome this situation and resume normalcy in our lives.

Meanwhile, stay at home and stay safe.
